The car as a heat trap

The deadly consequences of "I am back in a minute..."

Never underestimate the heat generated in a car, even when it is cool outside. It can quickly become fatal for animals. Caution: Leaving the windows open or parking in the shade is simply not enough.

Temperature development in a car

Is the animal in distress and you cannot find its owner?

- 1. Contact police (117) or fire services (118) immediately
- 2. Do not leave the animal alone
- 3. Ask passers-by to help as witnesses and write down their contact details
- 4. Write down location, date and the make, colour and registration of the car
- 5. Document the situation with **photos** and **videos**
- 6. Wait by the car for the arrival of the emergency services

Should the animal be in immediate **mortal danger**, **act immediately** and rescue it from the car. Move the animal to a **shaded area**, cool it down slowly and offer some **water**. Contact a **veterinarian**!
